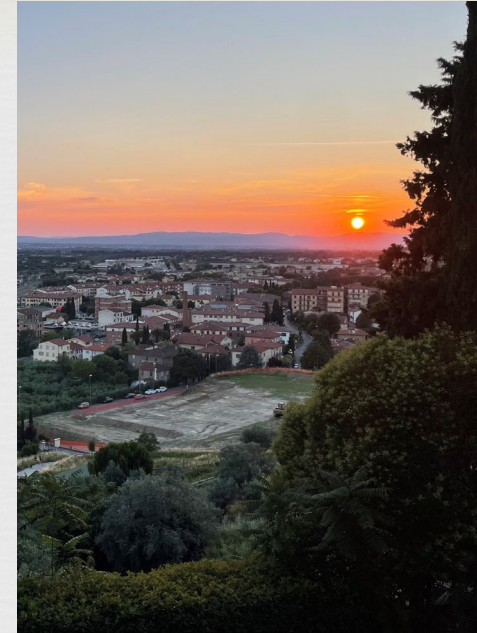


Math Study Abroad

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES:

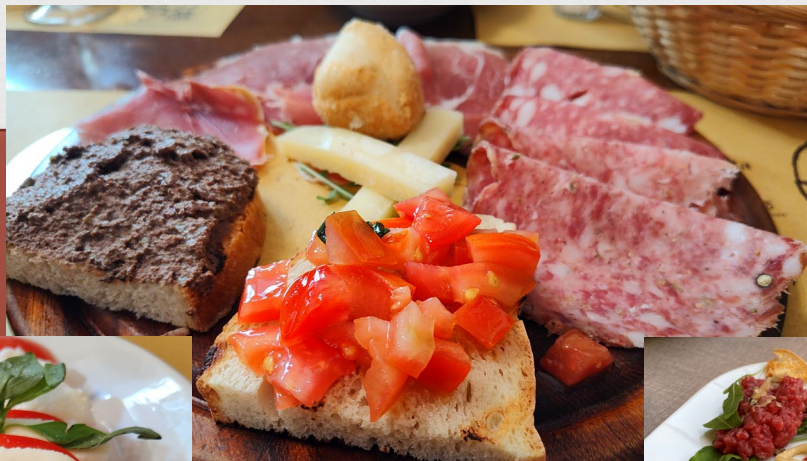
