

VMI'S KOREAN WAR ROLL OF HONOR

Lieutenant General Walton Harris Walker '09, USA.....	Commander, U.S. 8th Army in Korea, killed north of Seoul, Korea, December 23, 1950 when the jeep in which he was riding collided with a truck. He was the father of VMI's current superintendent, General Sam S. Walker '45.
Major William Edwin Dressler '38, USA	Reported missing in action July 14, 1950; declared killed in action in Korea March 5, 1953.
Major Frank Moorman Parker, Jr. '39, USA	A major in the Corps of Engineers, he was killed in an airplane crash in Korea, June 27, 1952.
Colonel Douglas Hampton Hatfield '40, USA	Commander, 91st Squadron, 19th Bomber Group, based on Okinawa; killed in action in Korea April 12, 1951.
Captain William Harris Hickman '40, USA	Reported missing in action December 1, 1950; declared dead.
Major Clarence Ames Martin, Jr. '44, USA	Reported missing in action November 29, 1950; declared officially dead December 3, 1953.
Captain John Alton Tate '44, USA	Killed in Korea, May 23, 1951.
Captain Robert Douglas Ramsey, Jr. '45, USAF	Missing in action over Korea, December 1951.
First Lieutenant John Olin Bates, Jr. '47, USA	Killed in action in Korea, June 12, 1952.
Lieutenant Patteson Gilliam '47, USAAF.....	Killed in action near village of Uisong, Korea, August 22, 1950.
Second Lieutenant Howell Garronne Thomas, Jr. '47, USA	Killed in action in Korea, July 14, 1950.
First Lieutenant John Adams Dille, Jr. '48B, USA	Jet fighter bomber pilot killed in plane crash at Itazook Air Base, Japan, Easter Sunday, April 13, 1952.
Second Lieutenant Floyd Albert Stephenson, Jr. '48B, USA....	Killed in Korea, December 13, 1950.
Lieutenant Irvin Edgar Nachman '49A, USA	Died January 29, 1951 in Tokyo from wounds received in action in Korea.
Second Lieutenant Earl Lester Valentine, Jr. '49A, USMC.....	Died August 27, 1952 on a hospital ship from head injuries received in action in Korea.
Lieutenant Charles Perry Walthour '49B, USA	Killed in Korea, September 1950.
Lieutenant Thomas Walter Tigertt '49C, USAF	Served in Korea; instructor at Nellis Air Force Base, Nevada, and killed in collision of jet fighter planes near Las Vegas, February 11, 1952.
Second Lieutenant John Wood Timmins, Jr. '49C, USA.....	Killed in action in Korea, November 19, 1950.
Lieutenant Robert Seymour Tauss '50A, USAF	Pilot in Korean War; killed in line of duty at Alexandria, Louisiana, December 22, 1953.
Second Lieutenant Robert Norman Smith '50B, USA	Killed on Heartbreak Ridge in Korea, September 24, 1951.
Captain Kenneth Edwin Taft, Jr. '50B, USMC.....	Killed in action in Korea, March 26, 1953.
Lieutenant Randolph Truslow Townsend '50B, USA	Killed in action in Korea, February 8, 1951.
Lieutenant Alan Maurice Volk '50B, USAF.....	Killed in airplane crash on Okinawa, June 8, 1952.
James Desmond Carey '51.....	Date of death unknown; a letter from his sister stated that he was killed on a mission in North Korea.
Second Lieutenant Eugene William Stewart '51, USMC	Died in the line of duty at Kuan-ni, Korea, May 18, 1953.
Lieutenant Stanley Wright, Jr. '52, USAF	Helicopter pilot; died during a rescue mission in Korea, July 28, 1954.
